**Appointment of Agency for
“Impact Analysis of Inter-Personal Communication Campaigns
Carried out in the states of Karnataka, Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu for DFP”**

The following amendments in RFP No. BECIL/ DFP/ Impact-Analysis/ RFP/2016-17/02 for Appointment of Agency for “Impact Analysis of Inter-Personal Communication Campaigns Carried out in the states of Karnataka, Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu for DFP” are brought to the notice of all concerned.

1. Point No. h) under Para no. 1.3.1 shall be read as:

Bidder is required to submit a single EMD amounting to INR 1,50,000.00 irrespective of the no. of states for which bidder is intended to bid.

2. Para no. 1.5 shall be read as:

Insurance

*Successful bidder(s) shall take out and maintain, at their own cost, insurance against the risk for conducting the impact assessment study surveys, on BECIL/DFP’s request the bidder(s) shall show that such insurance has been taken out and maintained. **It is up to the bidder but BECIL will like to intimate that BECIL will not be responsible to compensate any losses / damages incurred by the bidder/s during the survey. It will be sole responsibility of bidder/s to settle these claims and bidder/s have to indemnify BECIL against any such claims in future.***

3. Para no. III clause 3.i under Proforma-I: Eligibility Criteria shall be read as:

*“Bidder/ Lead member of the consortium should have an average annual turnover of **INR 2 Crores** in the last three consecutive financial years i.e. 2013-14, 2014-14 & 2015-16. The company should be a profit making company.”*

4. Para no. I clause 1.a under Proforma-II: Technical Criteria shall be read as:

*“The bidder/ (any member of the Consortium) must be engaged in similar kind of work in India; **During last 5 years**, bidder/ agency must have successfully completed at least two similar kinds of projects with value INR 20 Lakhs each or above in the field of impact analysis/ impact assessment/ program evaluation of projects of Government/ NGOs in rural/ semi-urban areas.”*

5. General Requirement:

- *Consortium is allowed, however the lead/ front bidder has to clearly specify the details, number of members in consortium and their expertise.*
- *An undertaking by lead/ front bidder is essential (Undertaking on a non-judicial stamp paper of INR 100/- certified by Notary) also consortium agreement should be submitted along with bid documents.*
- *It is the sole responsibility of lead/ front bidder for the smooth and timely completion of the project.*
- *The bidder/ (all members of the Consortium) should submit the undertakings/ certificates / documents as required in the RFP document.*

- *The lead bidder of the consortium will be evaluated against the Pre-Qualification Criteria/ Eligibility Criteria.*
- *All members of the Consortium/ bidder should enclose documentary evidence for fulfilling the RFP conditions.*

All the other terms and conditions of the request for proposal document BECIL/ DFP/ Impact-Analysis/ RFP/2016-17/01 shall remain unchanged.
